Job Description: The Research Associate is expected to help with day-to-day coordination to run a programme and also help with research related to gender issues. The person should be passionate about issues related to gender and women at work.

They should have strong communication, writing and social skills. They will be expected to handle lot of communication related tasks as well as liaising with various departments. Having good analytical skills to conduct rigorous research is a bonus.

Required Technical Skills: Microsoft Word, Excel. Any statistical tool is a bonus

Qualifications:

- Applicants should preferably have a master's degree.
- Applicants should have strong qualitative skills; quantitative skills additionally would be great. Demonstrated academic work in issues related to gender would be beneficial.

Duration and Location: The position will be initially offered for a period of one year from January 2023 and may be extended depending on performance. The position is based in Ahmedabad. IIMA provides access to the library and computer center for all Research Associates. If selected, the candidate is expected to manage their own accommodation, outside the IIMA campus which is centrally located within the city of Ahmedabad.
