Overview

The summer placement process for the Class of 2021 of the Post Graduate Programme (PGP) in Management at IIM Ahmedabad was successfully completed in November 2019 within three clusters with students being placed across sectors and functions of their choice. The successful completion of the recruitment cycle for the batch stands testament to the high quality of students at the institute and the robust nature of the placement process that provides adequate flexibility to both students and recruiters.

Placement Process

The summer placement process was completed within 3 clusters. Firms were grouped into cohorts based on the profile offered and groups of cohorts were invited to campus across different clusters. As in previous years, students were provided the flexibility of making "dream" applications to firms of their choice in a subsequent cluster even with an offer in hand. This gave students the flexibility and choice to build careers in sectors of their preference.

Sectoral overview

Firms from different sectors and geographies participated in the process at IIM Ahmedabad. Recruiters in the management consulting cohort included A. T. Kearney, Accenture Strategy, Alvarez & Marsal, Bain & Company, Boston Consulting Group, Deloitte USI, GEP Consulting, KPMG, McKinsey & Company, Roland Berger and Strategy& among others. Prominent recruiters in the investment banking and markets space included Arpwood Capital, Avendus Capital, Bank of America Merrill Lynch (India and Hong-Kong), Citibank, Credit Suisse (Singapore and India), Goldman Sachs, JPMorgan, HSBC, Moelis, Morgan Stanley and Nomura (Singapore and India). There was increased participation in the PE and VC domain this year with Arga Investment Management, Brookfield, Edelweiss, Eight Roads, Kois Invest, MIRA Infra Fund (Macquarie Group), Morgan Stanley Infra Fund, Omidyar Network, NIIF, Temasek, Venture Highway and White Oak participating, among others.

Among the Banking, Financial Services & Insurance recruiters, American Express and FinIQ participated in the process among others.



Sales and marketing roles were offered by regular recruiters like AB InBev, Coca-Cola, General Mills, HUL, ITC, Kimberly Clark, Mondelez, Nestle, P&G, and Wipro Consumer Care, and new recruiters such as Dabur, among others. The General Management & Leadership cohort saw participation from recruiters like Aditya Birla Group, C K Birla Group, Mahindra Group, Reliance India, RPG Group and TAS. In the Retail B2B & B2C space, we had firms like Amazon, Cloudtail, Flipkart and Udaan. The Consumer Tech cohort comprised of firms like Adobe, Microsoft, Ola Cabs, OLX and Uber. Enterprise Tech consisted of companies like Intel and Sprinklr.

Top Recruiters

Boston Consulting Group was the top recruiter for the Summers 2020 process with 23 offers. Among the global banks, Nomura made 8 offers while HSBC made 7 offers. FinIQ and Avendus Capital were the top recruiters in the BFSI cohort having made 6 offers each. HUL recruited 14 students, making it the top recruiter in the Consumer Goods cohort while the Aditya Birla Group was the top recruiter in the General Management cohort with 6 offers. Amazon was the highest recruiter in the Retail B2B& B2C space, having made 10 offers, while Microsoft was the leading recruiter in the Consumer Tech cohort with 8 offers.
