

## PGP-FABM Summer Placements 2023-2024

### IIM Ahmedabad

The PGP-FABM (Post-Graduate Programme in Food & Agribusiness Management) Summer Placement process for the batch of 2023-25 was completed successfully on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2023. The process was carried out in hybrid mode. 45 students of FABM Class of 2023-25 will join their respective companies for completing their summer internships during April-June 2024. The successful completion of the placement process within a day is a testament of the high-quality learning experience at the institute, the robust placement process that provides adequate flexibility to both recruiters and students.

The industry responded positively to the FABM students seeking summer placements, with 43 companies taking part in the process. The placements encompassed a diverse range of roles across various sectors, including, but not limited to Agri-Inputs, Commodity Trading, Conglomerates, Food Supply Chain, Food Processing, Agri-Tech, Agri Consulting, ESG Consulting, Dairy, FMCG Retail, and more, ensuring a well-rounded recruiter participation across functions and domains.

The placement process witnessed regular recruiters who reaffirmed their confidence in the program such as Accenture, Ernst & Young (EY), Marico, Godrej Agrovet, BAYER, UPL, Nestle, PepsiCo, Olam Agri, DeHaat, Coromandel, International Flavors & Fragrances (IFF), PI Industries, McCain, Vegrow, Grow Indigo, Varaha, AMUL, Banas Dairy, Hester Biosciences, Krishika Advisory Services (KAS), and Terviva. Many new recruiters also showed a keen interest in the batch, which is visible by the participation of industry giants like Happilo, Storia Foods, ReNew, Harvest Global, Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), Beaphar, Louis Dreyfus Company (LDC) among others. The program also witnessed participation of firms from Conglomerates like DCM Shriram, RPG Group (Harrison's Malayalam), Murugappa Group (Coromandel International) and Export Trading Group (ETG).
