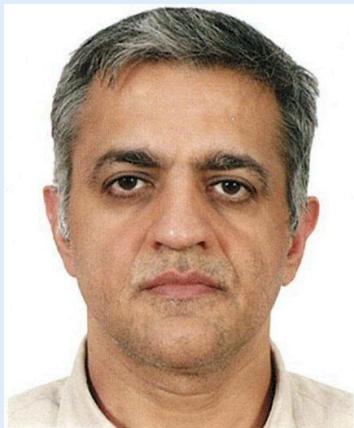

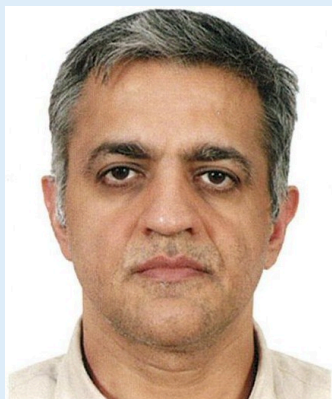

Achievements & Appointments



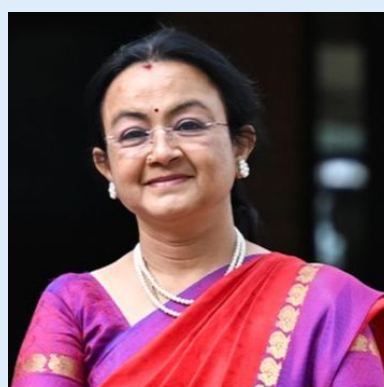
